

The 2015 event sees the Chemspec Europe show back in Germany for its 30th anniversary event, set to be the largest Chemspec Europe on record.

As the European leader in chemical sales, exports, investment and R&D expenditure, Germany plays a decisive role in meeting global chemical demand Germany produces a wide range of products, including fine chemicals, specialty chemicals, petrochemicals, inorganic chemicals, synthetic materials, agrochemicals and fertilisers, laundry and cleaning agents, cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, paints and adhesives.

According to Germany's "Verband der Chemischen Industrie e.V." (VCI), over 90 percent of Germany's more than 2,000 chemical companies are small and medium-sized enterprises. Some 434,000 workers are employed in the chemical and pharmaceutical industry. Many of them are graduates in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics. The industry's estimated expenditures for research and development were around €9.6 billion in the year 2012, according to VCI. This positions the German industry at third place in an international comparison.

According to data from "Germany Trade & Invest", Germany holds third place worldwide in the number of patent applications filed for chemical products. Germany is also among the top-ranking countries in its number of patent applications for pharmaceutical products.

A mere three years after the crisis, nearly all chemical companies were showing sales growth and operating margins in the double digits due to a drive to ensure efficient running of plants and production facilities which has allowed the German Chemicals industry to thrive in the face of rising energy costs.

WHY COLOGNE?

Cologne - the chemical hub

- About 230 chemical companies of all sizes and sectors with a total of around 70,000 employees have established themselves in this region.
- The ChemCologne region (Chambers of Commerce and Industry of Cologne, Aachen, Bonn-Rhein-Sieg, Düsseldorf, Mittlerer Niederrhein, Wuppertal-Solingen-Remscheid) is vast and generates the equivalent of 20% of Germany's total chemical turnover.

Cologne - the well connected travel hub

- 90 minutes away or less from almost all capital cities within Europe
- 15 minutes by car and direct train connections between Koelnmesse and Cologne-Bonn Airport
- High Speed ICE and Thalys trains connecting Koelnmesse with the airports of Frankfurt, Brussels and Amsterdam
- 30 minutes by train from Düsseldorf International Airport and an average of 60 minutes directly from Frankfurt Airport to Koelnmesse
- Direct flights to over 160 countries



CHEMSPEC EUROPE 2015 AT THE HEART OF THE FINE CHEMICAL INDUSTRY

of those who attended one or more of the allied conferences and other show floor content rated quality of these as 'good' or 'excellent'


